What is the SOLARIS network?

The SOLARIS France network is a "Human Internet," a network of mutual aid and solidarity that starts in your immediate neighborhood.

It is, of course, completely free. It represents a gathering of human beings who, each on a voluntary basis, act for all, and who together, when necessary, act for one.

It operates in a tree-like structure within a physical mesh of all the people who join it. The tighter the mesh, the better it works. So it begins right around you.

In the difficult times we are experiencing, it will ensure that no one remains isolated in the face of their problems. It will provide rapid and local responses to everyone's needs. It will connect people and strengthen these connections more than ever before.

It equips itself with its own means of communication in the event of a breakdown of traditional communication methods.

It operates organically thanks to good information flow, without hierarchy, without leaders.

How does the "Human Internet" work?

Just like the digital Internet. You have a need, you submit a query to a search engine, and it provides the most relevant answers.

Here, all these steps are human. You enter the network and contribute to a kind of local directory of available resources—skills, equipment, accommodation, land, etc. This handwritten resource database is constantly updated and available from reliable people in your immediate geographic area.

At any time, you can submit your request for assistance to these referents, who will direct you to where you can find the answer from people closest to you. You can then contact them yourself, or the network will do it for you.

As already mentioned, in the event of a failure of usual communication methods, the network is equipped with autonomous communication means, and it will indicate how you can access them yourself.

The geography of your area is thus meshed with cells that multiply endlessly, like the cells of the human body, staffed with coordinators who have an overall vision of the geographic cell and ensure its smooth operation, and referents, who hold the local directory. Each cell is autonomous, without hierarchy, and connected to the others.

The service you provide to someone within the network will likely be returned to you by someone else. The person you assist will not necessarily be the one who assists you when the time comes.

The system is not based on commercial exchange, nor on direct barter, nor even on the idea of a service exchange. It is based on benevolence toward everyone, and what you give in one place will always be returned to you elsewhere when you need it.

Is there someone behind the SOLARIS network?

Yes, all of us.

Those who founded it and established its framework and operations are entirely volunteers, affiliated with no political, religious, or other structure, nor any secret society. They receive no remuneration or advantage of any kind from anyone.

We provide the description of a tool—a Human Internet—that anyone, anywhere, can replicate around them and adapt to their local particularities.

How to join the network?

To join, you can join an existing cell or send it an email. If the cell does not exist, send an email to solaris.suisse@pm.me

We will contact you to help you quickly set up your local network and connect it with others.
